Greetings, Arts Students and Parents!

The School Committee has approved our trip to Orlando, Florida with the high school visual and performing arts students. The trip dates would be **Friday, April 17, through Wednesday, April 21, 2019**. We will audition to march up Main St USA, and sing somewhere in the Disney parks.

The **cost of the trip** is **\$2000** per student. This price covers all expenses (flight, lodging in quads, ground transfers, admissions, food, tips & gratuities, performance fees, and other ancillary expenses) except for personal spending money. Family members are allowed to join us – there will be a **price increase** for single, double, or triple occupancy. Please remember that our itinerary is planned for our students, and if we run into a numbers problem – like 3 too many people for a bus or something – students in our groups must take precedence over extra family members.

To sign up, please go to [www.tritonarts.net](http://www.tritonarts.net). There is a form there for download (you can also type into it before you download/print.) You might want to bookmark that page as all pertinent materials will be uploaded there. Follow that up with **a deposit of \$250 by September 13, 2019** to reserve your spot. I will not count you officially “on the trip” until I have that deposit in hand!

If you wish to use a credit card, I’ve set up the initial deposit Eventbrite. You can register for it just like any other event. Fees will apply, but fees can’t be refundable. **The first \$175 of this deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE on or about October 2, as it will be used to secure airline tickets.** The payment plan and cancellation policy are on the reverse side of this sheet. **Deposit of \$250 and sign up form** due September 13, 2019. This deposit will become largely non-refundable on or about October 2 – see cancellation policy below. The fee structure and payment plan is as follows.

*Cancellation/Changes*

*Written notice of all Cancellations and name changes must be made in writing, and dated and signed by the Group Leader. The most current rooming list received by our office will serve as a guideline when individual cancellation fees become applicable. Cancellation charges are as follows:*

- Upon Receipt of Deposit (in October) \$175 per person cancellation fee
- October 13, 2017 – December 1, 2019 \$200 per person cancellation fee
- December 2, 2017 – January 10, 2020 \$425 per person cancellation fee
- January 11, 2018 – February 19, 2020 \$525 per person cancellation fee
- February 19 – March 9, 2020 \$1200 per person cancellation fee
- AFTER MARCH 9, 2018 NO REFUNDS

Please Note: Any non-refundable deposits made to bus companies, special attractions, transfer services, etc. will not be refunded. This could affect total cancellation fees.

Aside from the aforementioned, I will have to be making payments to the bus company that takes us from here to the airport, and there a few other incidentals (tips for bus drivers, and a couple of meals in airports.) Thus, the payment schedule for this trip is the following. (If you wish to pay early, you may.)
